STREAMLINED ADMISSIONS

- No SAT/ACT (unless US curriculum is followed)
- No lengthy institution essay
- No class ranking requirements
- No reference letters required in advance



ADMISSION TIMELINE

- Mid-August: Application window OPEN
- 15th March: Document deadline
- January – April: Admissions decisions made
- 1st May – Acceptance deadline

NB: Deadlines may differ by university/scholarships/international status
