

Personal Statement of Experience

The Personal Statement of Experience (PSE) essay is **strongly** recommended for students applying to a Queen's first-year program. The PSE and Supplementary Essay are **mandatory** for all Commerce students.

English Language

English Language Proficiency (ELP) Requirements: Do you live in a country where English is not the acknowledged primary language? Find out if you are required to submit ELP scores...

QBridge is an English language pathway to Queen's University for students who are academically competitive for admission to a Queen's undergraduate degree program, but who do not meet the required admission standard for English language proficiency. The QBridge programs ensure that students are linguistically, academically, and culturally prepared to complete their Queen's undergraduate degree studies.

Program Requirements

Smith School of Business, Commerce (QC)

Mathematics at the Advanced Level and two other Advanced Levels. English at the GCSE (Ordinary) or Advanced Level. Minimum Mathematics predicted/final grade of A and minimum English predicted/final grade of A.



If you apply to Commerce you will be required to submit a Personal Statement of Experience (PSE) in addition to a Supplementary Essay. The recommended last date to submit both is February 15th.








Typically

- Overview of educational background
- Brief biographical information
- University and course selections
- Like UCAS.... without the statement or reference

Post Application Support





Will be given a login to applicant portals, which will update with the status of the application and possibly have requests for more information or materials;



May have to send transcript, predicted grades or supplemental materials themselves;



Potential for additional writing or video interview (U of T) from this;



NB: these portals may not send emails, so students should check once a week.



- Will likely have to send a transcript of something about achieve and predicted grades;
- These may have to be mailed: use of FedEx or similar is recommended;
- It's also helpful to have a contact at the university who you can email with questions
