

### APPRENTICESHIPS....

...are a vocational pathway that combine academic learning with on-thejob training, where you'll...

- ...earn a salary
- ...spend at least 50% of your time at work over the course of the apprenticeship.
- ...spend time attending college, university, training provider, or training at work.
- ...complete assessments / qualifications during and at the end of the programme.





### APPRENTICESHIPS + / -

### **INCENTIVES**

- employed & paid a wage
- gain qualifications / full degree
- no fees & no debt
- gain a head start
- acquire graduate level skills, especially in areas of growth need
- a large & growing range of choices
- good chance of permanent employment

### **DRAWBACKS**

- cannot yet gain access to some careers
- starting salary lower than graduates'
- higher qualifications can take longer
- might miss out on the added benefits of full-time education
- have a different kind of application process outside of UCAS
- location & accommodation can be a big limiting factor



### WHAT TO EXPECT



Applying for an apprenticeship like applying for a job – and it can get competitive

Applicants will need a professional attitude, a CV (ideally showcasing some experience) and determination

No one portal or centralised application (yet) – each application stands alone

Often a multi-stage application process; school support given for each stage.

Being limited to certain locations, regions, and timescales; and less opportunities for internationals

May make sense to apply in parallel to a UCAS application

Need to start exploring early. Use taster days, outreach and work experience programmes as a lead in

Practice and theory

Apprenticeships typically consist of 80% on-the-job training, and 20% studying. For some opportunities this means 4 days per week at the workplace and 1 day at a college, and for others this means you will work for about 10 months a year, then you'll spend 2 months just studying.


